Continuing Education for Our Members

JAS has provided two continuing education programs for our members since 2004. The basic program is made mainly for members with clinical experience of up to three years. It consists of basic courses (clinical practice and related issues) and a case report to be presented to a local group of members including two supervisors. The advanced program is designed for members who have completed the basic program. It includes taking advanced courses to update knowledge and skills and collecting points awarded for professional activities such as presentation or publication of papers, and participation in national and local professional activities. For members with clinical experience of more than five years and who have completed the advanced program, JAS provides a more advanced program leading to a certification in specialized areas.
